Lawlessness Will Not Be Tolerated: Metsimaholo Leaders Unite After Unlawful Bash Shocks Sasolburg CBD

Metsimaholo Local Municipality convened a high-level meeting at the Public Safety Offices in Sasolburg this afternoon following a shocking and unlawful bash that erupted in the Sasolburg Central Business District (CBD) over the past weekend and spilled into the early hours of Monday morning, 06 October 2025.

The meeting brought together key stakeholders, including the Fezile Dabi District Police Commissioner, senior SAPS officials, the Executive Mayor of Metsimaholo Local Municipality, Cllr Jack Malindi, the Member of the Mayoral Committee (MMC) for Public Safety, Cllr Lefa Nhlapo, representatives from the Free State Liquor Board, municipal By-Law and Traffic Enforcement Units, local business owners, and other concerned stakeholders.

The urgent gathering expressed grave concern and disappointment over the reckless and irresponsible conduct displayed during the incident, where scores of people were captured in a widely circulated video, consuming alcohol openly in the streets and parking areas outside a drinking establishment in the heart of the Sasolburg CBD. The footage, showing people drinking freely in full view of the public and motorists, has sparked outrage and alarm among residents and leaders alike.

Executive Mayor Cllr Jack Malindi condemned the incident in the strongest terms, describing it as an act of lawlessness that tarnishes the image of Metsimaholo's towns and undermines efforts to build a safe and orderly community.

The meeting resolved that unlawful events will not be tolerated in Metsimaholo. Stakeholders, including police, law enforcement, and the Liquor Board, committed to stronger cooperation and stricter control measures, while business owners were urged to comply with liquor regulations and municipal by-laws.

The meeting ended with a united commitment from all stakeholders that Metsimaholo will not tolerate lawlessness, pledging joint action, strict enforcement, and community vigilance to restore order and uphold the rule of law.
